Mr Rose mentioned the list of entertainments and the arrangements to provide refreshments to participants. He mentioned that he had applied for grants on the basis of a two year programme. It was agreed that if this event was successful it would greatly enhance the community spirit in the parish. 12 Penistone Wards Clean and Green Initiative

It was noted that this initiative was to be regarded as an extra possibility to have work undertaken in the parish. The Clerk was to prepare a list of suggested tasks for circulation round members. Once agreed, this list would become the definitive programme that the Green and Clean Initiative would be asked to undertake

13 Oxspring Parish Neighbourhood Plan

Members noted that this plan was moving ahead steadily and that publication of the finished work was due shortly

14 Safety of the Playground.
