2.1 The minutes of the meeting held on 21st November 1990 were approved as a true record.

3. Matters arising

3.1 Future use of School : The School Building Committee have decided that it is not a feasible proposition for the Parish Council to manage the building for community use. The Clerk was asked to inform Barnsley M.B.C. of the decision, but point out that the Parish wished to retain the Museum and suggest that it might be incorporated in the Rural Housing Scheme.

3.2 Telephone Box : It was suggested that the incident regarding the two ladies falling outside the telephone box should be reported to the Director of Public Services at Barnsley M.B.C.

3.3 Footpath through The Delf : The Chairman reported that she had met with the representative from Don Valley Training Services regarding the reinstatement of the footpath through the Delf and he promised to carry out the necessary remedial work.

3.4 Wall Building, The Delf : The Wall Building team had promised to re-commence work shortly.

3.5 Ian Clancy's Field : The Chairman had met with Ian Clancy, who expressed a wish that the building stone required for the Delf is removed from his grassland before the growing season commences.

3.6 Christmas Party : It was agreed by all that the Christmas Party had been a success in the new venue namely the Chapel.
