1. Apologies for Absence

1.1 The Chairman reported that due to family commitments Councillor M.D. Flanagan may not be attending the meeting.

2. Minutes of the Council Meeting held on 16th January 1991

2.1 The minutes of the meeting held on 16th January 1991 were approved as a true record.

3. Matters arising

3.1 Future use of School: An acknowledgement of our letter was received from Barnsley M.B.C. informing us that our proposals were receiving active consideration.

3.2 Telephone Box: It was suggested that the Clerk approach the Brewery regarding the access roadway to the Delf to ascertain the ownership. The Chairman agreed to make herself available if a site meeting was necessary.

3.3 Wall Building - The Delf: Councillor Mrs Godley Down reported that Don Valley Training Services had promised to complete the wall building in the Delf by the end of March 1991.

3.4 The Delf Project: The Councillors thought that they had acted in haste when agreeing to order the gates for the Delf Project at the last meeting. A local discussion had taken place since that meeting and it was agreed that Councillor Mrs Godley Down cancel the order placed with Don Valley Training Services after discussions with them. The Clerk expressed concern that this cancellation directive had not been dealt with through the Council.

A further quote had been received from United Engineering Steels at Stocksbridge, this being for £585.00. It was agreed that this be accepted and Councillor Mrs Godley Down was asked to place the order.
