SS 2020/2` Feasibility of the Project

It was agreed that the project as outlined at the recent parish council meeting was feasible. It was further agreed that the project should be named "*Sandstone to Southwark*". The project now needed the support of the full meeting of the Hunshelf Parish Council in February 2020

SS 2020/3 Aims and Objectives

The following aims and objectives were agreed

- a Documentation of the history, geology and social conditions in the Quarry industry of Hunshelf Parish.
- b Identify, record and preserve the wagon way across the Isle of Skye together with any remaining traces of the quarrying
- c Identify, record and preserve the wagon way across the cricket field.
- d Research, identify and restore as much of the wagon way on Hill Top Lane as is feasible.
- e Make Hill Top Lane suitable for vehicles alongside the preservation of the wagon way
- f Research the route of the sandstone's journey from guarry to Southwark
- g To supply and fit a commemorative stone in Southwark

SS 2020/4 Noted Items

- a. The project would be in three phases, viz., research, preservation and presentation.
- b. That the Lottery Heritage Fund would be an appropriate source to commence seeking funds

- c. That grant funds should be available for such a project
- d. That records must now be kept of all hours spent on the project for use as a contribution. DH to record such hours
- e. Councillor P Watts would be apprised, by DH, of the results of this meeting prior to the parish council meeting
- f. That BT has the letter from Southwark Council permitting the installation of a commemorative stone at the site of the Green Moor Imperial Wharf
- g. That further, more minor aims, would be incorporated into the scheme as the project develops

- a DH to contact Lottery Heritage for an application form
- b DH, KA and BT to liaise over completing the application form
- c BT to ascertain the appropriate form of geophysics to use for the line of the wagon way on the sports field and Hill Top Lane. BT to ascertain quotes for such work.
- d MT to consider what research would be appropriate for this project
- e DH to present these minutes to the next meeting of the Hunshelf Parish Council for approval
- f DH to record the number of hours spent on the project
