2020/42 Apologies for non-attendance

2020/43 Declarations of Interest

The Chairman declared an interest with respect to the retaining wall at Delph Mews. Cllr Battye declared an interest with respect to unadopted roads in the parish.

This was noted by the meeting.

2020/44 Parish Projects

The Parish Council considered and discussed a list of proposed parish projects. It was agreed that the current Covid situation was still affecting what work could be undertaken at present. However the Council would look to draw up a list of projects with priority status and a timescale for completion.

It was agreed that the drawing up of a parish plan was a high priority but the original proposal to hold a parish event would have to be postponed until 2021 at the earliest.

The Clerk is to forward a parish boundary map to Cllr Watts to help ascertain the ownership of some of the dry stone walls in the parish.

The Clerk was asked to report some damaged dry stone walls on Well Hill and Green Moor Road to BMBC Highways.

The Parish Council discussed existing heritage items such as the Pumphouse and the work required.

It was agreed that the quotation received for the repairs to the playground surface be discussed at the ordinary Parish Council meeting.

It was agreed that the revised list of parish projects be an agenda item for the next ordinary meeting of the Parish Council.
