2021/37 – Goal posts

The Clerk reported she was still waiting for a response from the National Lottery.

2021/84 – Queen's Platinum Jubilee

The Clerk reported that Green Moor Cricket Club is going to discuss this at their next meeting later this month. It was agreed that Cllr Mrs Austin is to contact Cllr Barnard about putting a package of projects together and the possibility of accessing Ward Alliance funding.

2021/99 Parish Projects

It was agreed that Yorkshire Water is to be contacted about pallets and a sign which had been left on Well Hill following the recent repairs to the drain. It was noted that a section of wall near the repair site had collapsed.

As BMBC Highways would not accept any responsibility the Clerk was asked to discuss this matter with the Penistone East Ward Councillors about how to resolve the issue.

It was noted that the commemorative stone should finally be ready to install at the end of January.

It was agreed that the signs for Pea Royd and the improvements to the playground be delayed until March 2022.

2021/100 Team Green Moor

Claire Derrick reported she had contacted Pictorial Meadows about planting wildflower seeds to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee in June. The team have identified an area in the Delf field and the Millennium Green which would be suitable for planting. Twiggs had been asked to assist and the team were meeting a representative later during the week to look at how much seed would be required. It would then be possible to estimate the costs involved.

The Clerk reported the following:

a. Site at Hazeldene

Planning Enforcement has had a long and detailed conversation with the landowner and hopes the landowner will heed the instructions given. The notice served was regard the installation of screening, of which there is currently a singular tree. It was pointed out that the plans state trees (plural) so the landowner is to rectify this as a matter of urgency. The officer is comfortable that once there is more than one tree for the screening of the shed the Council will be satisfied that the notice has been complied with. Should there be any further allegations of planning breaches these will be looked on a case by case basis. It was pointed out that enforcement powers are discretionary and consequently Enforcement is not obliged to take action and any punitive measure has to be fair and proportionate.

The Clerk was asked to discuss this matter further with the Penistone East Borough Councillors.

b. Site at the Burrows.

Planning Enforcement has visited the site and there are 2 structures at this location, an eco house being constructed and a stable. Whilst the stable is large construction there are horses in there.
