**2023/79 Apologies for non-attendance**

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Mrs L. Godley.

**2023/80 Declarations of Interest**

The Chair declared an interest with respect to the agenda item Parish Projects and specifically Green Moor Carol Singers.

**2023/81 Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2023**

**2023/82 Matters arising from the Minutes**

**2023/83 Parish Projects**

It was noted that the Parish Council had met informally prior to this meeting to discuss and develop the proposed Parish questionnaire. A further informal meeting will be held prior to the December meeting.

David Rose reported he had drafted an application, on behalf of Team Green Moor, to the new Pride of Place UKSPF Grant Programme. Grants are available for those working in the community and voluntary sector. The application would include requests to fund the replacing of the playground retaining wall, improvements to Peck Pond, a video guide to the pump house and replacing some gardening equipment used to maintain the verges and planters.

After discussion the Parish Council agreed to support the application.

11<sup>th</sup> December 2023

The Clerk reported receiving the annual playground report and she had sent a response to BMBC Park Services outlining the proposed improvements which are to be made to the playground.

The request by Green Moor Carol Singers for financial assistance to pay for a musical director this year was discussed again. It was agreed that the grant to the Green Moor Carol Singers of £120 towards the cost of a musical director stands.

Cllr Garrity reported he had contacted Barry Tylee as a member of the Peak & Northern Footpath Society to inform him of a chained gate on the public footpath leading up to Hunshelf Bank.

The Clerk reported that the BMBC Countryside Rangers had repaired the stile near Hunshelf Hall.

This was noted by the meeting.

#### **2023/84      Wind Turbine**

The Clerk reported that she still had not received any response from the officer dealing with this issue.

The Chair raised the issue of low frequency sound and the effect it has on the body. The Chair asked how many residents had responded and had submitted diaries and had made recordings of the noise.

It was agreed that the Clerk is to contact Regulatory Services expressing the residents concern about noise levels and the need to proceed and resolve this issue.

#### **2023/85      Team Green Moor**

Betty Allott reported that regular maintenance work is continuing despite the bad weather. The Team had a successful fund raising event at a recent table top sale, a further event was taking place on 25<sup>th</sup> November.

It was agreed that the ride on mower be sent for its annual service.

#### **2023/86      Communications from the Public & any Reports from the Clerk**

David Rose requested that BMBC Museum Services be asked to include the village of Green Moor in the display at the entrance to the museum in the Town Hall.

The Clerk is to contact Museum Services.

The Clerk commented on the temporary road closures which are being put into place on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> December 2023 to facilitate the Sheffield and Hallamshire Motor Club South Yorkshire Stages Rally. The road closures will affect many of the roads in the west of the Borough for most of the day. The road closures had not been confirmed as the event was to be discussed at the BMBC cabinet meeting to be held on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2023.
