**2024/47 Apologies for non-attendance**

**2024/49 Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2024**

The Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2024 were confirmed.

**2024/50 Matters arising from the Minutes**

There were no matters arising from the Minutes.

**2024/51 Parish Projects**

It was agreed to have a further meeting to discuss the parish plan, prior to the next Parish Council meeting, to refine the project list and allocate budgets.

A special meeting with BMBC Penistone East councillors is still to be arranged.

A meeting with Claire Derrick is to be arranged to discuss the suggestions raised by the the parish questionnaire for the Hunshelf Chat.

Updating the website is to be considered and the Clerk is to contact the website company for further information. The use of social media in a restricted manner is also to be considered.

As part of the Pride of Place grant the purchase of a generator for the Pump House is being researched. The generator would be available for use at other community events.

14<sup>th</sup> October 2024

It was agreed that the Parish Council should purchase a waterproof box to store the generator.

The Clerk reported receipt of a letter from residents raising their concern about the collapsed dry stone walls on a section of highway from Green Moor to Hunshelf Hall. The residents also raised concern about the possible imminent collapse of sections of the walls.

It was agreed that the Clerk is to contact BMBC Highways.

It was noted that following the Pride of Place grant, Team Green Moor had purchased a new small lawn mower and a leaf blower which have been gifted to the Parish Council. The Clerk is to update asset list.

The evacuation of Peck Pond was discussed and Cllr Watts is to discuss this with the landowner.

Cllr Mrs Godley gave a verbal report on the work of the social sub group. It was noted that this group was a separate sub committee. Several community events have been organised and had been advertised in the latest edition of Hunshelf Chat. There followed a discussion about funding.

It was agreed that the next edition of Hunshelf Chat is to be published in early November.

Some of the Pride of Place grant is to be used towards the repair the playground wall and the Chairman reported he had met one contractor to discuss the repairs.

It was noted that another contractor is required to fit the new plate for the Isle of Skye viewpoint.

It was noted that the new benches were to be delivered later in the month.

Residents present at the meeting expressed concern about the wind turbine which they feel is excessively noisy. It was noted that this was raised by residents completing the recent parish questionnaire. It was agreed to further work is required to evidence the noise levels.

The above was noted by the meeting.
